## First Grade May Days 2024

We will be doing some activities in school for about 30 minutes each day in May. It helps prevent the month from dragging on as students anticipate summer vacation. We will still be learning (so it's still important that your child attends every day), but adding some extra fun.

Here are some suggestions for what your student can wear or bring to enhance the experience. Other days are not listed because your child won't need to wear or bring anything special. All these ideas are optional.

Remember to continue to follow school dress standards: shirts with sleeves and modest length skirts and shorts.

May 1 - May Day - Wear something with flowers.

May 2 - Sun & Moon Day - Wear clothes with stars, suns, or moons.

May 3 - Star Wars Day - Wear Star Wars costumes/clothes.

May 6 - Cinco de Mayo - Wear bright colors. Bring Mexican hats and instruments. Bring salsa and chips to share.

May 8 - Superhero Day - Dress like a superhero.

May 10 – Animal Day – Bring a small stuffed animal (no bigger than a backpack).

May 14 - Insect Day - Dress like an insect; wear antennas and wings. (We may play a game with a spray bottle, so make sure you can take off anything that shouldn't get wet.)

May 15 - Pirate Day - Wear pirate clothes.

May 16 - Pajama/Read-A-Thon Day - Wear pajamas and bring a small pillow (no bigger than a backpack).

May 17 - Game Day - Bring games from home to share and play in the classroom for 30 minutes. No video games.

May 21 - Field Day - Wear tennis shoes and clothes appropriate for the weather. You may want to bring a water bottle, sunscreen, and sunhat.

May 22 - Western Day - Wear cowboy hats, boots, and/or bandanas. Bring stick horses.
